Aligned with the objectives of the Environment Education Programme (EEP) under the Environment Education, Awareness, Research and Skill Development (EEARSD) scheme, CMS VATAVARAN and the Punjab State Council for Science & Technology (PSCST) collaborated to implement initiatives in Punjab, supported by the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MoEF&CC). This programme aimed to supplement formal education by imparting non-formal environment education to children and youth, motivating them to adopt sustainable lifestyles, integrating knowledge dissemination, experiential learning, and behavioural change strategies.

The programme provides children and youth with the opportunities to participate in hands-on activities designed to develop their scientific temper, critical thinking, creativity, and nurture values like compassion and empathy, while strengthening their understanding of sustainable solutions. It fosters a collaborative ecosystem where participants emerge as stewards and leaders for environmental conservation.

TRANSFORMATIVE FORUMS

As part of the Sustainable Lifestyle Workshops and Campaigns, the programme includes:

- Film Screenings followed by Guided Discussions to raise awareness about environmental issues.
- Interactive Sessions organized to discuss the linkage between ecosystem health and human wellbeing, bridging local and global perspectives.



CREDIBLE PLATFORM

The programme provides a credible platform for children and youth to participate in:

- Hands-on Painting Contests that depict environmental stories.
- Mobile-Filmmaking (MOJO)
 Workshops to create short films
 on environmental themes.
- On-the-Ground Environmental Reporting Projects to document local environmental issues.

SKILL ACCELERATOR PROGRAMS

The Skill Accelerator Programs under EEP include:

- Nature-based Learning Modules conducted during Nature Excursions, where participants engage in direct learning from nature.
- Collaborative Campaigns organized to amplify grassroots voices and promote community-led practices in biodiversity conservation and circular-economy initiatives.





This multi-pronged approach is rooted in the principles of the National Education Policy, 2020, and complements the LiFE (Lifestyle for Environment) Mission. The initiative aims to foster pro-environmental behaviour and leadership among youth, through participatory learning and community engagement.
