"Breath of Change" Campaign Launched to Raise Awareness on Air Pollution in Delhi-NCR

The Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MoEFCC) and the Commission for Air Quality Management (CAQM), jointly launched, a three-month strategic communication campaign called "The Breath of Change" aimed at generating greater public engagement and awareness on the issue of air pollution in the Delhi-NCR region. The campaign is being implemented through Delhi based EIACP Centres viz. Sulabh IIHH, TERI, SPA, JNU & WWF and media outreach partner for this campaign is CMS VATAVARAN.

Running from July to September 2025, the campaign aims to complement the scientific and regulatory efforts of the government with media-based outreach, youth-led activities, and creative citizen engagement. The initiative will culminate in a national-level Film Festival and Forum on 7th September 2025, in alignment with the International Day of Clean Air for Blue Skies (7th September).

Key Campaign Components:

- Plantation Drives: Community greening activities under #EkPedMaaKeNaam promoting environmental restoration.
- College Fetes and Screenings: Outreach events at universities and colleges across Delhi-NCR, encouraging them to become #VayuMitra for clean air in the region.
- IEC & Outreach Programs: Social media campaigns, public engagement, and design support for EIACP-led activities.
- Short Film Competitions & Festival: A nationwide contest inviting entries across three
 categories, culminating in a two-day screening and award event in Delhi.
- Workshops, Panel Discussions & Media Consultations: Capacity-building sessions for student and professional journalists on storytelling and air quality reporting.
- Mobile Journalism (MoJo) Trainings: Hands-on workshops for youth to create participatory videos on pollution and its solutions.
- VATAVARAN Ki Chaupal Hindi Podcast Series: Four live episodes spotlighting environmental
 experts, activists, and change makers.

"'Breath of Change' is not just a campaign, it's a public call to action. We are bringing people, institutions, and stories together to show that clean air is possible when we act collectively. Our aim is to empower communities, especially the youth, to drive this change on the ground." Dr. Vasanti Rao, Director General, CMS VATAVARAN.

The campaign will also establish a **common style guide for outreach**, a shared drive for content exchange, and a communication model that ensures all stakeholders including the public are aligned in vision and action.
